Should a technical plan review be required, the City of Roanoke strives to complete these reviews in ten (10) working days. Should information be missing or additional information be required, the review process may be delayed. I also understand that all contractors and subcontractors are required to have the proper trade certifications when required, a current business license for the City of Roanoke and current state licensing when required by the Virginia Department of Professional and Occupational Regulations (DPOR). I also understand that I am required to conform to all applicable requirements of the Virginia Uniform Statewide Building Code, the Zoning Ordinance for the City of Roanoke and all other applicable laws and ordinances.
